2. I cannot charge for hunting or access to the acres enrolled in this program.
3. The area will be signed by FWP showing it is enrolled in the Pheasant Release program. Signs must remain in place for the entire hunting season following the release.
4. The location of the project and landowner's contact information will be published in the annual Upland Game Bird Access Guide.
5. All birds released must be at least 10 weeks old and fully feathered.
6. A minimum of 40% of the released birds must be roosters.
7. Violation of the terms of any agreement entered into as a result of this application will require repayment to FWP of funds received under the program.
