

Rules and Regulations

Preserve Open 6 days a week: Wednesday-Monday Sept.1st -March 31st

Preserve Rules and Regulations

- Preserve hunts broken into half-day scheduling. (9-12)(1-5) Negotiable for time of year
- Guests and members allowed in hunting preserve (See pricing list)
- 4 bird minimum per ½ day, 8 bird minimum per full day
- Weekend and holiday reservations required 7 days or more in advance
- Guest reservations require 25% down payment to book dates
- Members will be charged 4 birds down payment per reservation either charged to account or marked off pre paid amount.
- All guest and member down payments are non-refundable but can be used to reschedule hunt date if cancellation is made 7 days or more in advance.
- Scratch birds are free of charge to members only.
- Free scratch hunts for members only on Wednesdays of non-holidays and non booked hunt days, reservations must be made as space is limited.
- Reservations are mandatory for any use of hunting preserve, which includes the number of guests with members.
- All pre paid birds are forfeited March 31st of hunting year and are non-refundable
- All bagged birds must be handled in the following scenarios; we make every attempt to eliminate unnecessary game bird waste.
 - Free to clean game birds on site and take with.
 - Pay \$3.00 for Northern Edge to clean and process bird
 - Pay \$2.00 to leave the bird as is with Northern Edge
 - We will store birds for free until the end of hunter's scheduled hunt
- All hunters will check in and check-out with the exact amount of game taken from preserve as required by Montana Fish Wildlife and Parks
- No alcohol consumption before hunts
- Risk waiver to be signed by all participants along with an acceptance of all the rules and regulations
- Safety is the #1 priority at Northern Edge, any unsafe action or activity will be handled according to what managements deems necessary.
- Hunting dogs highly recommended for preserve
- We can provide you with a dog and a guide at your request. (see guest prices)
- Birds are purchased as "release" birds prior to the hunt and we in no way guarantee the harvesting of birds purchased. Northern Edge will make every effort to provide the experience each hunter desires. We take no responsibility over the ability of a hunter and or his dog to find and successfully harvest game.

Free Range Area Rules and Regulations

- Big game hunting on free range area is not allowed at this time, management of wild animals is in place, hunting of big game will be available in the coming years
- Bird hunting will be the priority game in the Free Range area and as the season progresses Northern Edge will designate specific areas and dates for specific species.
- Absolutely no walk on hunting in free range area, reservations and permission must be granted by Northern Edge for any and all use of private property under Northern Edge jurisdiction.
- Free range hunting will require a check in and check out policy as well as game check.
- In order to provide our members and their guest with exceptional habitat and game opportunity we will be implementing rest days to any portion of the Free Range Area as deemed necessary. One hunting group per 7 days.
- It is the hunter's responsibility to abide by all posted rules within the free range area and by all rules and regulations of Montana Fish Wildlife and Parks.
